

How to use SENECA:

Check that you have already set up an account and that you know your password. If you need help logging in, ask for a different help sheet.


Step 1: Log in




Step 2: Click on classes and assignments at the top: [If your class isn't here, click join class and copy the code your teacher has given you]




Step 4: Select the class you need for that lesson






Step 6: Click start learning next to the assignment you need. (go through the lesson following the instructions)




Step 7: after completing the first task (if there is more than 1) click continue




Step 8: it now shows you which task you completed and which still needs to be completed. You can either click on the words 'finding terms' or continue.



Step 9: Complete the next task.
